Also,

- 1) Minutes, Treasurer's and Phone reports were accepted without anything new.
- 2) There was no Website report. However, Lynne M. said she has a friend who is willing to help spruce-up our page. It was agreed that a "locked" site be set up for a preview by members of our district.
- 3) Simon, Chairman of the Literature Committee, is resigning effective November. We are asked to PLEASE be considering nominations from our groups for that position/service work. On that same note, there has been "talk" of setting up a Central Office for D-13. Concern still remains that we may not have large enough population base to support it.
- 4) There was no Institutions report as Our Chairman, Brad, was not present. Great concern caused us to recommend Brad be contacted to see if he was still interested in chairing this committee since he has not been present since April, 2008. Be prepared to seek nominations for this position/service work should Brad decline to show an interest when contacted this month. Those visiting our jails need to find out if they are getting their Grapevine subscriptions.
- 5) MYCYPAA was discussed. A request that we submit group donations to help support our youth attend was heard by Walter. That a letter to all our GSR's was subsequently sent out since the meeting asking for their group's support for our young people to attend.
- 6) The 2010 State convention: Laura suggested we muster 6-8 greeting teams. Lynn M. said he knew of some sources where we could purchase souvenir-type memorabilia to sell at the convention which could help off-set our expenses. It was noted that all revenue generated above our costs (if any) ought to be turned over to the Area to help defray their costs. Lynn M. will investigate and report back at our next district meeting in November.
